## 2025 PIONEER OIL DAYS CAR SHOW JUDGING CLASS GUIDE

This is guide intended to provide generalized information on standard descriptions of car show judging classes. Descriptions may vary from show to show.

The choice of judging class is decided by the car show participant. Registration staff are not able to choose a judging class for the participant.

- **Antique:** Vehicles that are at least 45 years old. (1980 and earlier) Vehicles may be restored to original specifications or be a "survivor" vehicle. Modifications are not typically allowed.
- **Street Rod:** Typically vehicles from the 1930s and before. Conservative modifications are generally permitted. If major modifications have been made, the Best Modified category is generally recommended.
- **Classic:** Vehicles that are at least 20 years old. (2005 and earlier) Vehicles may be restored to original specifications or be a "survivor" vehicle. Modifications are not typically allowed.
- Muscle: Original vehicles from the 1960s 1980 that have powerful engines, primarily V8 high performance engines. Modifications are not typically allowed.
- **Modern Muscle:** Vehicles from after 1980 that have powerful engines, primarily V8 high performance engines. Some modifications are generally allowed.
- **Motorcycle:** General category for any motorcycle. No restrictions on year or modifications.
- Foreign & Other: Vehicles from countries outside of the United States and vehicles that do not fall into the criteria of the other categories are permitted.
- Corvette: Corvettes from any year are permitted with minimal modifications.
- Mustang: Mustangs from any year are permitted with minimal modifications.
- Best Modified: Any vehicle that has been modified from the original specifications.
- Truck: Trucks from any year are permitted with minimal modifications.
- Jeep: Jeeps from any year are permitted with minimal modifications.
